Additional ideas and plans for NARL Field Day at Mill Pond Park in Newington were discussed.

George, AB1GL, talked about attending a packet radio SYSOP conference in Farmington. At the conference, he learned they are looking to establish for more packet nodes in the area.

Club members discussed and reviewed the situation with the W1AW and W1OKY repeaters at their present location. Newington town officials are still discussing plans to establish a new tower for the Newington Police and Fire Department repeaters.

Paul, KB1QQI, provided a summary of the Newington Library 5 K Race that was held on May 19. He also announced the Scottish Rite 5 K Race that is scheduled for Saturday, July 27, in Newington.

The May meeting minutes and the treasurer's report were accepted.

The meeting adjourned around 8:00 PM.
